This was followed by a Question and Answer session, where deeper philosophical questions like differences between eastern and western philosophy and the link between karma and destiny were discussed.







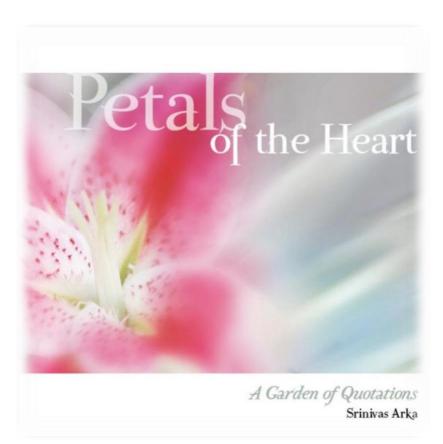
